However, three suppliers - including Germany's Atlas Copco - plan to localize production in Buenos Aires Free Trade Zone, potentially stabilizing costs.

Don't overlook logistics. Shipping 100 air tanks from Shanghai to Puerto Madryn costs \$2,800-\$3,200 via LCL sea freight. Compare this with Grupo Galvao's local inventory in Santa Fe - their price per piece includes door delivery but runs 12% higher than imports.
