2. Husqvarna DM 230

Wholesale price: \$19,900/unit (3+ units)

Ideal for small contractors. Survived 6-month tests in Paracas desert conditions. 47% faster cleanup vs Chinese alternatives.

3. Siton ST-C800

2025 Quotation range: \$11,200-\$16,800

China-made rig with 93% parts compatibility with German models. Best-selling model at Ferreyros equipment fairs.
