Check spare part stock in Cordoba/Rosario warehouses

Compare fuel efficiency using Argentina's diesel price per kWh (\$1.08 avg.)

Case Study: San Juan Mining Co. saved \$14,000/year switching to Atlas Copco's variable-speed model. They negotiated a 10% discount via supplier Holmann Group by bundling 3 units.

Most buyers don't know this: Under Argentina's Resolution 31/2024, crawler compressors bought before July qualify for 5% tax rebates if certified "low-emission." Bring this up when requesting price quotations.
