Meanwhile, industrial projects like the Nairobi Expressway used Chinese-built core drilling rigs at 40% lower costs than German alternatives.

3. Ask About ROI: A Kakamega gold mining company saved Ksh 2.4 million annually by switching to a hybrid diesel/electric rig from Shandong, China.
