- Diesel 5HP rigs: \$17,900-\$21,300 per unit

How to Get the Best Wholesale Deals

Top Saudi buyers use this 3-step strategy:

- Compare price per piece from 3+ suppliers (China vs Germany vs local stock)
- Request VAT-exclusive quotations for commercial projects
- Negotiate bulk discounts (5% for 5+ rigs, 12% for 20+ units)

Case Study: Jeddah Drilling Co. Saves 19%

By ordering 15 German-designed rigs through a Shanghai wholesaler, they cut costs vs buying single units locally. Sea freight to Dammam port added \$820 per rig - still cheaper than Saudi dealer markups.

2024 Market Trends Impacting Prices

Saudi Arabia now imposes 15% VAT on commercial equipment imports, but exemptions apply for:

- NEOM-bound machinery
- Green construction projects
- Government infrastructure tenders

Chinese manufacturers like TYCORP now offer Arabic-language manuals and Ramadan payment plans to compete with European brands.
