- Tank material (steel vs. aluminum)

The Silent Deal-Breaker Most Buyers Miss

Italy's new Decree 144/2023 mandates Tier 4 emission standards for all construction equipment. This impacts crawler air compressor prices in two ways:

- Non-compliant units face 15% import tax
- Certified models get 5-7% green subsidies
