Step 2: Negotiate payment terms. Top suppliers like DrillMaster Kenya offer 30% upfront, 70% after delivery. Avoid 100% prepayment deals - they're red flags.

Step 3: Compare total cost of ownership. A \$70,000 rig with \$5,000/year maintenance beats a \$60,000 rig needing \$15,000/year in parts. Use this formula:

$(\text{Initial Price} + 3\text{-Year Maintenance}) / \text{Drilling Meters per Year} = \text{True Cost per Project}$
