Option 1: Direct Import from China

Best for: Bulk orders (5+ units). Price per piece drops to EUR58,000-EUR72,000. Lead time: 45-60 days. Key brands: Sinovo (3-year warranty) and TSC (ISO 9001 certified).

Option 2: EU Wholesale Suppliers

Recommended for urgent orders. German suppliers like Bauer and Atlas Copco offer 2-week delivery. Expect 8-15% higher cost than China imports, but includes CE certification.

Option 3: Local Rental-to-Own

Sandvik and Epiroc Norway provide flexible plans. Pay EUR1,800-EUR2,300/month per rig. Upgrade after 24 months. Ideal for short-term projects like snow melting systems in Tromsø.
