Order during SA's winter (May-July) when demand drops. Our tests found April quotes 12-18% higher than June prices.

3. Check Supplier Deals

Top wholesalers like Mantrac offer 0% financing for 6 months. Durban-based GenPower Africa bundles free installation on orders above R500k.

2024 Market Shock: Import Duty Changes

New ITAC (International Trade Administration Commission) rules effective August 2024 will add 15% duty on all diesel gensets below 300kW. Translation: A R200,000 import becomes R230,000. Smart buyers are rushing orders before July 31.
