Market Alert: Argentina's New Import Rules Impacting Prices

Since March 2024, Argentina's Resolution 45/2024 slashed import taxes on mining equipment by 8%. This could reduce drilling bit costs from overseas suppliers by late 2025. However, temporary currency controls still add 6-12% conversion fees on USD transactions.
