How to Buy Smart in 2024

First, check if suppliers comply with Sweden's SEK 5.2 billion tax rebate program for drill part innovation (valid till Q3 2025). This lets top factories like Sandvik Coromant sell premium bits at near-Chinese price points.

Second, demand ISO 9001:2015 and API 7-1 certifications. Third, test 3-5 suppliers with small orders before committing. As Jens Lundqvist, procurement head at LKAB, told us: "Our drilling bit supplier Sweden checklist eliminated 83% of underperformers in 12 months."
