3 Red Flags in Supplier Contracts

1. FCA Incoterms: You pay unpredictable port fees
2. MOQs over 100 pieces: Ties up capital in slow-moving stock
3. 30+ day lead times: Often signals drop-shipping from China

Dutch law mandates part warranties of 12+ months - use it to negotiate. Pro tip: 83% of suppliers offer extra 5% discounts for wire transfers vs. letters of credit.

The drilling bit parts market here thrives on repeat business. Ask suppliers for their client retention rate - leaders like DrillPart NL report 79%+ year-on-year repeat orders.
