- Heavy-duty DTH hammers: \$150-\$280

- German-engineered units: \$300-\$550

Pro Tip: Peru's new green mining policy (effective July 2024) favors eco-friendly tools. Look for suppliers offering Tier 4 emission-compliant models - 42% of buyers get tax breaks for these.

1-year warranty terms

Spare parts availability in Arequipa/Lima

Step 3: Test Before Bulk Order

Reputable suppliers offer sample tools for onsite testing. Juan Perez from Trujillo Construction Group says: "Testing a drilling hammer on Andean rock saved us from buying 200 faulty units."

With Peru's mining sector projected to grow 7.6% in 2024, smart buyers lock in wholesale prices before peak season. Request quotes from at least 3 suppliers - prices typically drop 8-15% for orders over 300 units. Check if your supplier offers consignment stock near mining hubs like Cerro de Pasco.
