Drilling hammer suppliers in Portugal often inflate prices for first-time buyers. Use these strategies:

Ask for FOB (Free On Board) pricing from Chinese factories to bypass local markup

Request DDP (Delivered Duty Paid) terms if importing via Leixoes Port

Bundle with drill bits - 70% of wholesalers offer package deals

Pro Tip: The Portuguese Construction Materials Association offers free VAT (23%) calculators for bulk imports - essential for accurate ROI comparisons.

Update: New Tax Incentives for Eco-Friendly Tools

Since March 2024, buyers of electric drilling hammers with energy-class A ratings get 5-8% tax rebates in Northern Portugal. This applies to Cordless models from Makita, Milwaukee, and Festool.
