Step 3: Time Your Purchase

Q3 (July-Sept) sees 15-20% lower prices as EU infrastructure projects slow. Avoid Q1 - post-budget rush inflates lead times by 3 weeks.

With Turkish lira volatility, always request USD/Euro-denominated price lists. A Konya-based contractor saved TL287,000 (~\$9,300) in Q2 2024 using this tactic during currency fluctuations.
