Top vendors like Kaeser and Atlas Copco now offer "pay-per-hour" pricing (EUR3.50-EUR5.80/hour) perfect for 2-week bridge repairs. Meanwhile, Hamburg-based Rentex provides free air hoses with 3-month rentals - a EUR240 value.

Last month, a wind farm project in Lower Saxony cut costs by 18% using portable piston diesel compressors instead of electric models. With Germany's 2030 green energy goals, expect more tax rebates for low-emission rentals.
