Always verify supplier credentials through Nigeria's SONCAP database. Pro tip: Negotiate 30% deposit, 50% after production photos, 20% post-inspection. This saved an Enugu cement plant ₦7M in 2024 when a supplier failed cylinder pressure tests.

Ready to lock in 2025 rates? Email at least 3 suppliers this week - prices typically spike 9-12% during Q4 rainy season projects. Whether you need 3 units or 30, focus on price per working hour rather than sticker cost. A ₦500K cheaper unit that breaks down monthly could cost ₦2.1M/year in lost productivity. Now that's a wholesale deal that actually works.

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
