2024 Buying Checklist: Avoid Costly Mistakes

Always confirm:

Voltage compatibility (Japan uses 100V/200V systems)

Local service centers (check maps on supplier websites)

Import tax (5.1% for non-Japanese brands)

One Yokohama buyer nearly lost JPY47,000 repairing a Malaysian import because parts took 8 weeks to arrive. Now they only work with suppliers stocking piston rings locally.
