1. Verify certifications: Look for SNI (Indonesian National Standard) labels on imports
2. Test payment terms: 30% upfront, 70% post-delivery is common for first-time buyers
3. Check voltage compatibility: Indonesia uses 220V/50Hz power - mismatched specs cause 37% of equipment failures
4. Prefer FOB deals: Ship from Qingdao or Guangzhou ports to cut 14% vs. CIF rates

The Hidden Factor: Spare Parts Availability

23% of drill breakdowns in remote Sumatra sites occur due to unavailable components. When negotiating rock drill wholesale prices, confirm suppliers stock:
