Top suppliers like Wanyuan Machinery and Sandvik now offer Malaysia-specific deals. Key moves:

1. Ask about the "MY Construction Partner Program" - some give 5% cashback on 10+ unit orders.
2. Compare FOB prices from China (usually 12-18% cheaper than EU brands) vs total ownership costs.
3. Demand test reports: Real-world drill penetration rates should match specs.

Johor-based MegaBina Corp. recently secured 9-month price locks on 15 rock drills by committing to future orders. "The supplier even stores our extra units in their Pasir Gudang warehouse," explains procurement head Linda Tan.

When to Expect 2025 Price Drops
