Follow these steps:

Specify hole diameter - 75mm vs 150mm bits change quotes by 40%

Compare FOB vs CIF - Shipping from China adds EUR900/ton

Ask for package deals - 78% of suppliers discount drill+compressor combos

Pro tip: Greek industrial zones like Oinofyta offer 15% tax rebates for bulk purchases over EUR50k. A Larissa-based quarry saved EUR7,500 last month using this scheme.

When's the Cheapest Time to Buy?

Prices drop 9-12% during:

February-March (pre-construction season)

November (year-end inventory clearance)

"We got a Sandvik drill for EUR58k in March 2024 - same model cost EUR64k in August," reports a Patras mining supervisor.

Supplier Showdown: Local vs Imported Rock Drills

Greek dealers like Epirotiki offer same-day spare parts but charge 8-11% more. Chinese manufacturers now ship to Piraeus Port in 18 days via the "Silk Road" rail route. Consider fuel efficiency too - a EUR30k drill burning EUR150/day in diesel loses to a EUR38k electric model costing EUR23/day.

The choice? For short-term road projects, rent locally. For 5+ year mining operations, import with a service contract. Either way, demand a drill test at the Hellenic Technical Chamber's Athens facility first.
