Watch Out for Scams: 3 Red Flags

Last quarter, NAFDAC seized 1,200 counterfeit adapters in Kano. Avoid sellers who:

- Refuse to test devices live
- Can't provide previous usage history
- Offer prices below ₦2,000 for branded models (likely stolen or faulty)
