For wholesale deals, check Divisoria's "Adapter Alley" shops every Thursday morning - early buyers often snag Sony or HP adapters at PHP 280-550 per piece. Statista notes the Philippines' used electronics market grew 8% this year, outpacing Thailand's 5.2% growth.
