2. Calculate True ROI

Factor in repair costs (avg. PHP5,500/bit) and downtime losses. Example:

Buy 5 bits at PHP28,000 each: PHP140,000

Add PHP12,000 for shipping/repairs

Total = PHP152,000 vs. PHP340,000 for new units

Result: 55% cost saving with proper maintenance.

3. Negotiate Bulk Deals

Suppliers in Manila and Davao offer free sharpening services for orders above PHP300,000. Some even bundle drilling fluid discounts. Always ask for price per piece breakdowns to compare apples-to-apples.
