But here's the kicker: 43% of discounted stock never hits public listings. Industry insiders email their parts inventory to regular buyers first. Want access? Partner with a broker - companies like Lyon's AchatPro charge 3% fee but secure 12-30% bulk discounts.

Ready to compare real-time price per piece offers? Use this formula when negotiating: $(\text{Dealer's asking price} \times 0.85) + (\text{Shipping cost} / 2)$. Most vendors meet halfway. And remember: Late December to February sees 9-14% price drops as dealers clear year-end inventory.
