Local suppliers often omit these from initial quotes:

Import fees (15-23% for non-EU equipment)

Replacement parts availability (Chinese models vs EU brands)

Tool compatibility (Check if adapters are included)

Case Study: Krakow vs Szczecin Price Gap

Identical Atlas Copco SB 202 units cost EUR430 more in Krakow last quarter. Why? Coastal cities like Szczecin get faster shipments from German refurbishers. Always ask suppliers about port proximity and customs support.

MachineryHub PL (Warsaw): Specializes in Bauer and Sandvik models

EU-RefurbDirect (Poznan): German-engineered units with lifetime support

RockTools Global (Gdansk): Best for small-batch orders under EUR5k

Negotiation tip: Mention "bulk purchase" even for 2-3 units. Most wholesalers offer 8-12% discounts. And don't skip the test drive - faulty hydraulics account for 67% of post-purchase complaints.

The Warranty Game

Polish law requires 12-month warranties on certified refurbished gear. Yet only 22% of eBay sellers comply. Stick to UDT-certified suppliers. It's worth paying EUR200 extra for proper documentation - especially when reselling later.

Final thought: Check OLX.pl daily. Last month, a Gdynia contractor sold 5 barely-used Furukawa hammers for EUR1,150/unit. Deals exist if you're ready to move fast. Now you're armed with 2024's real prices, risks, and loophole-free buying strategies. Time to drill smarter.
