Confirm factory service history via QR code

Tip: Look for ISO 9010-certified resellers. They offer 6-month warranties - rare in Thailand's used equipment market.

ROI Calculation: New vs Second-Hand

A Surat Thani mining company compared:

New hammer: ฿320,000 with 3-year fuel/maintenance costs (฿12,000/month) Used hammer: ฿145,000 +  
฿18,000/month repairs

Despite higher upkeep, the second-hand option saved ฿79,000 in Year 1. Always factor in Thailand's 7% VAT  
and ฿2,500-฿7,000 transport fees per delivery.

Ready to negotiate? Contact suppliers before Q4 - monsoon season (July-October) drops prices by 10-15% as  
projects stall. Check equipment during dryer months for accurate performance tests.
