hours. Ask about their July-Sept 2024 clearance sales - stock rotates fast!

Remember: Always calculate ROI before buying. A KRW1.4M rod that lasts 1,200 hours beats a KRW1.1M rod failing at 600 hours. Watch for suppliers offering free re-threading services - it adds 30% lifespan to used rods.
