"We saved \$85,000 buying a used Soilmec SR-40 from China," says Luis Mendez, a Buenos Aires contractor. This mirrors a regional trend where engineering drilling rig price differences drive cross-border deals.

3 Steps to Get Competitive Quotations

First, verify if suppliers like SINOVO (China) or local dealer Maquinarias Cordoba have Argentina-specific inventory. A 2024 study shows Chinese used rigs dominate 41% of Argentina's market due to lower price per piece. Second, request moisture content reports and engine hours - key factors affecting resale value. Third, compare warranty terms: Leading suppliers now offer 6-12 month guarantees on refurbished units.

Case Study: Drilling 30% Faster With ROI

Rosario-based GeoDrill Co. purchased a 2019 Bauer BG 28 for \$127,000, 35% below new rig cost. After modifying it for Argentina's sedimentary rock layers, they completed water well projects 30% faster. "Our ROI came in 8 months instead of the usual 18," notes CEO Clara Fernandez.

Supplier Pitfalls & Tax Calculation Guide

Watch for rigs originally designed for Brazil's tropical climate - 23% buyers reported compatibility issues in Argentina's Patagonia region. Always confirm:

Import taxes (currently 18% for used machinery)

CE certification validity in South America

Spare parts availability in Mendoza/Salta provinces

Where Prices Will Shift This Year

With Argentina's new mining incentives (Law 27,614), demand for second hand drilling rigs could push prices up 8-12% by Q4 2025. However, Chinese platforms like Zoomlion and XCMG plan to flood the market with
