- Undercarriage wear (common in Amazon Basin rigs)
- Non-compliant emission standards
- Missing safety certifications

- Soilmec SR-40 (2017-2019): R\$550,000-R\$720,000
- Bauer BG 28 (2015-2018): R\$480,000-R\$650,000
- Chinese XCMG XR180D (2020-2022): R\$310,000-R\$450,000

Chinese models now hold 28% market share due to lower price per piece, but European rigs maintain higher resale value. Always request a quotation with breakdowns for:

- Import taxes (if purchasing from abroad)
- On-site inspection fees
- Customs clearance support

4. Use escrow payments - Protect your funds until the rig passes field testing.
