Norwegian environmental laws now require EUR3,500-EUR8,000 emissions upgrades for pre-2020 diesel rigs. Top suppliers like Sandvik and Bauer include this in their price lists, but grey-market sellers often don't.

For urgent projects, try Norway's authorized resellers:

Bergen Heavy Machinery (5-year warranty): 12-18% higher prices, but 24hr delivery

Scandinavian Rig Traders: Best for budget buyers - 35+ rigs under EUR100k

EU Wholesale Option: Poland's HeavyTech Export offers group discounts - 3+ rigs = 9% price cut

Pro Tip: Time Your Purchase Right

Norwegian rig prices drop 7-9% between October-January when snow halts projects. Use this seasonal dip to your advantage. Check supplier websites every Friday afternoon - Oslo vendors often list clearance stock before weekend auctions.
