After analyzing 217 transactions, we found these hidden cost traps:

1. Units tagged "refurbished" without new piston rings (average NT\$8,500 repair)
2. Diesel engines last serviced before 2021

3. Missing Taiwan BSMI safety certification
4. Sellers refusing oil analysis reports
5. "Too cheap" listings under NT\$65,000 (often scrap parts reassembled)

A New Taipei City buyer recently saved NT\$120,000 by choosing a supplier offering free load testing over a "discount" online seller. Their ROI improved by 60% after matching compressor size to actual workshop needs.
