Supplier Secrets You Should Know

Top Manila suppliers report 35% of their used piston compressors come from Japan/Germany factories upgrading equipment. These units often have 80% lifespan remaining but sell at 50% of original price. Ask sellers: "Is this unit from a facility closure or regular rotation?" Closure sales often mean better-maintained machines.

Watch Out For

A Batangas buyer recently got scammed with a compressor that failed after 3 weeks. How to avoid this:

- Insist on CE/ISO certifications

- Test run at 75% max PSI

- Check for oil leaks around piston seals

Legitimate sellers like Cebu Industrial Traders offer 7-day return policies - use this period for thorough testing.

When Does Buying Used Make Sense?

Purchase a second hand piston electric air compressor if:

- Your project lasts under 18 months

- You need backup units during peak seasons

- You're testing a new service market

But choose new if you require:

- 24/7 continuous operation

- Strict noise level compliance

- Smart monitoring features
