Since March 2024, South Africa requires all imported second-hand stationary air compressors to meet NRCS

safety standards. This has:

- Reduced "grey market" imports by 30%
- Pushed prices up 8-12% for certified units
- Made local refurbished units more competitive

Why German-Refurbished Units Dominate

Compressors reconditioned in Germany (like Kaeser or Boge) hold value best - they account for 60% of premium used compressor sales in SA. A 2023 study showed:

- 92% still operational after 5 years vs. 67% for Chinese units
- 15% higher resale value
