Negotiate with China Direct: 73% of Chile's imported used rigs come from Shanghai and Guangzhou factories. Ask for EXW (ex-works) pricing to control shipping costs.

Time Your Purchase: Prices drop 9-14% during Chile's winter months (June-August) when drilling slows.

Case Study: Los Lagos Farmer Cuts Costs 40%

Dairy farm owner Marco Fernandez needed a rig for emergency water access. By comparing price lists from 6 suppliers and getting a quotation for sea freight taxes, he landed a 2019 Furukawa HCR9-ES for \$23,700 - originally priced at \$39,000 new.

Last year, 1 in 5 used rig buyers in Chile reported mechanical issues within 6 months. Always:

Verify engine hours (ideal: under 2,000 hours)

Test drill pipe threads for wear

Request CNC inspection reports

The Chilean Association of Drilling Contractors offers free checklists - use them. Also consider ROI: A \$20,000 used rig that drills 10 wells/year pays for itself in 14 months at Chile's average \$200/well service fee.
