Verify seller credentials: 40% of Polish rig sellers on Allegro lack proper equipment licenses
Request video inspections: Top suppliers like DrillingProsEU now offer live video calls to demo rigs
Ask about subsidies: Poland's "Clean Water for All" program offers EUR4,000 rebates until Dec 2024
