Check hour meters: Under 3,000 hours is ideal for diesel engines

Verify import history: Many European/US rigs enter Australia via Singapore

Request live tests: Reputable suppliers let you inspect rigs in action

Pro tip: Look for rigs originally used in limestone or clay - they sustain less wear than those used in granite regions like Western Australia.
