Step 1: Verify CFM (airflow) needs. Most Uzbek workshops overbuy. A 10 CFM compressor often suffices for tire shops.

Step 2: Demand ISO 9001 certification. Top Chinese brands like Denair and Screw provide this.

Step 3: Test before paying. Reputable suppliers in Andijan and Samarkand offer 1-week trials.
