Where to Buy: Local vs Imported Units

Poland's top three suppliers (according to 2023 industry surveys):

1. Airpol Compressors (Warsaw): Best for mid-range electric units
2. Rotair Europe (Krakow): Leads in heavy-duty diesel models
3. Techmex (Gdansk): Lowest-price Chinese imports with warranty

Power Play: Industrial Zones Offering Discounts

Special Economic Zones in Katowice and Lublin give tax breaks if you buy locally-made compressors. Last month, a steel plant in Szczecin combined zone incentives with EU grants to get a 75kW system for 74,000 PLN - normally 92,000 PLN.
