1. Check depth capacity first. Most Norwegian bedrock requires rigs with 150+ meter capability.
2. Compare warranty terms - Top suppliers offer 3-year coverage vs 1-year from budget brands.
3. Verify CE & NORSOK certifications. Avoids 75% of common customs delays.

With Norway's government offering 15% rebates on eco-friendly drilling equipment until 2026, now's the time to act. Reach out to suppliers before September - peak season starts October 1st.
